Possessing compassion for others and a wealth of Biblical wisdom, she has been honored by the California Legislative Assembly for her community work and is recognized as an anointed counselor for personal, spiritual, marriage and family, and life-coaching.

Pastor Davis joined New Creation in 1982 and was ordained in 1987. This achievement distinguished her as New Creation's very first female minister.

To our benefit, Pastor Davis learned about the Lord early in life. Both her greatgrandfather and grandfather were ministers, and, growing up in Asbury Park, New Jersey, her mother made it mandatory to attend church every Sunday, and to participate! As a result, Beverly began teaching Sunday School at age 10! Many years later, she taught Sunday School for a year in Bangkok, Thailand.

As a nurse and behavioral health educator, Pastor Davis has applied her religious studies, and her administrative and training skills to many roles in the church:

 Bethel Bible Study teacher ♦ Minister of Christian Ed. Directed Women's and Youth Days, Pastor and Church Anniversaries, Marriage Workshop & Re-

♦ Chaired the first NCC first Ministers Manual.

♦Established first sermon recording ministry and designed first church logo.

Pastor Davis currently serves as the Pastor & Spiritual Advisor for the Women of Faith Ministry. She has created three instructional books for the women, one on Forgiveness and Volumes I & II of "Ask Grandma" Everything you always wanted to know and were afraid to ask. Her Sundav sermons uniquely include handouts to encourage members' spiritual growth.

She wants us all to know that "prayer works." She prayed for God to search the world and find her a husband, and God did just that! She has been married to Mr. K.C. Davis for 33 years. It was God who sustained her while raising a family and working full time; earning a Bachelors Degree and taking graduate classes; and as she studied to become a licensed minister while actively working in the church.

Living out her calling, Pastor Davis' life and ministry

goals (the 4 H's) are to be Happy, Holy, Healthy, and Help to Others. Her two favorite scriptures are Psalm 91 and Proverbs 31:10.

She is a mother of 3, grandmother of 5, and great grandmother of 7. She is also 'Nana' to 20 little ones she nurtured over the years, and counselor and mentor to many more. Through God's grace, she is known as the one who opens her home to others, in fulfillment of her promise to the Lord when He blessed her and her husband with their home.

Pastor Davis continues to open her door and her heart to anyone that would like to come sit with her, and safely unburden their heart. She says, "People have things on their heart that they truly wish they could tell someone. I know how important it is, because I have had many people over the years come, and I have seen how it made a difference and the change that happened in their lives."

The Role of NCC Executive Board of Directors

Did you know? According to Church By-laws, our Executive Board of Directors is granted the duty to govern the church, and to meet semi-annually with the congregation at our June and December Business meetings.

The Executive Board is vested with the power:

• To perform any act and make any decisions concerning the welfare of, and on behalf of the church.

• To set clear rules, policies and establish priorities, and

• To work in partnership with the Senior Pastor to support the

Church and membership goals. Board Chair Brandy Anderson believes "Equally important to the *role* of the Executive Board, is *how* the Board executes the duties granted."

At New Creation the Executive Board, the Senior Pastor and the membership at large (congregation) form a partnership:

♦ All groups are represented on the Board. Each has an allotted time ("standing reports") at monthly meetings to voice concerns and ideas, obtain information, and vote on matters before the Board.

• The church membership is

represented by the Member-at-Large, to ensure information is received and disseminated directly between the Board and congregation.

• The church departments and auxiliaries are represented by the Leadership Council ensuring direct partnership with the Board.

• The church staff is currently represented by the Senior Pastor assisting the Board with operational matters of the church.

◆ Lastly, the Executive Board works directly with the Finance team to ensure each decision is within the annual budget approved by the congregation and to review and plan for those items impacting the church's future, and financial prosperity.

Chairman Anderson states, "The Executive Board's primary goal is to make all decisions with the inclusion of all represented partners, and with prayer and humility; that we listen, acquire knowledge and convey our decisions, especially the difficult ones, with truth and loving kindness." Amen!

Ministry Spotlight: History of Partner Services

In 2005, New Creation Church experienced a rapid increase in membership. This growth revealed the need for a central location where members could receive vital information about the church. At the same time, Pastor Gary had a vision that new members should feel more connected to their church. From his vision, the initial Member Services Ministry was created.

In the early stages, Pastor Gary collaborated with Sister Evelyn Bates-Clark to establish the new ministry. In the process, Pastor Gary began to lay out a plan that would help *all* members feel more connected to their church. Member Services was renamed and transitioned to the Partner Services Ministry.

Over time, Partner Services has grown tremendously. It is now fully established, with a team of elected officers, highly trained volunteer members, and expanded duties. The Ministry is currently led by two elected chairpersons and key officers. Throughout the years members have selected and approved a Statement of Faith, a theme, "Commitment to Serve" and a Scripture (Gal 5:13) that embodies the ministry.

Duties of Partner Services:

Partner Services is an intricate part of the mission and ministry of the church. Known to all by their burgundy blazers, this enthusiastic group of volunteers assists Church Partners and New Members to make meaningful connections within New Creation. They can steer people to the ministry that is right for them, and for the church.

Much like a hotel concierge, the Partner Services Office is a hub for important church information and is key for keeping church partners well informed.

Upon joining, each person must attend the New Members Class, which is one of Partner Services' most important assignments. Working with Spiritual Advisor Pastor Darian Woodruff, Partner Services schedules classes on 4th Sundays. This helps new members experience a meaningful and spiritual connection to the church. Members learn about our church history, the meaning of our Statement of Faith, Church Purpose, and Slogan. They are instructed in detail about the importance of developing a personal relationship with the Lord. Our Senior Pastor Reginald Gary stops in to extend a personal welcome to the new members.

On Sundays the team assists 40 plus partners and guests. As many as 16 at once have accepted the invitation for church membership.

Some of Partner Services additional duties are to:

- Maintain the church membership database
- Assist with Pastor and First Lady's quarterly 'Meet and Greet'
- Greet first time visitors
- Assist all auxiliaries with dispersing pertinent information
- Pray with members
- Assist as needed with church elections

Partner Services Team:

Pastor Darian Woodruff serves as the Spiritual Advisor. His wife Monica Woodruff currently serves as Chair, and Djuana Bryant as Co-Chair. A team of approximately 22 faithful servants make up the ministry.

Monica observes, "We are a family that supports and prays for each other. We also have fun outside of church, participating in activities such as bowling."



Partner Services also ministers to the community beyond church doors. Members have formed a partnership with nearby Marshall Elementary School. They mentor students and have also answered the call to provide toiletry items, clothing, and shoes for children in kindergarten through eighth grade.

The school is an ongoing ministry of Partner Services, and they are happy to receive any donations others would like to give throughout the year.


